Pagination (Chapter II.B.1) Each section must be individually paginated prior to upload (FastLane). If research.gov is used, the system will paginate.

The maximum length of the Graduate Research Plan Statement is two (2) pages. These page limits include all references, citations, charts, figures, images, and lists of publications and presentations. Both statements must address NSF's review criteria of Intellectual Merit and Broader Impacts.

Include Intellectual Merit and Broader Impact criteria. Read the program solicitation so you know what “Intellectual Merit” and “Broader Impacts” mean to the NSF, and show that your proposed research meets those criteria. In particular, do not just make up your own ideas about what “Broader Impacts” means.

Proposing organizations are responsible for identifying NSF-funded life sciences proposals that could potentially be considered dual use research of concern as defined in the US Government Policy for Institutional Oversight of Life Sciences Dual Use Research of Concern and for compliance with the requirements established in that Policy.
